#### Please note the following changes to begin January 2022:


- black sweatshirts are no longer allowed on regular uniform days
- black polos will be the only color approved for girls to wear
- No logo t-shirts on regular uniform days. (May be worn on PE days.)
- 90th anniversary t-shirts may no longer be worn

## SSP Sweatshirts / Jackets



- Red SSP sweatshirts
- Red school fleece jacket
- Grey school quarter-zip sweatshirt

## Exceptions:

- 8th grade may wear class shirts; and after acceptance letters are received high school sweatshirts may be worn on designated days
- Only 8th grade girls may wear nail polish
- 8th grade may wear their choice of sock color
- SSP Logo t-shirts may be worn on PE days

## Girls Only Plaids



Girls' Jumpers: PreK – 4th Grades Girls' Skirts: 4th – 8th Grades

Skirt and jumper length: must be longer than the students fingertips when arms are at their sides

#### **Bottoms**

- Black tights or black leggings (no more than 2 inches above ankle)
- Shorts that do not extend past the skirt

## Sock and Shoes

- Athletic shoes preferred (see handbook for more details)
- Athletic shoes may be any color
- Shoes must be in good condition with the laces tied

No outdoor hiking boots, snow boots, dress boots, moccasins, Ugg-type boots, flip-flops, high- heeled shoes, or any shoes that fall off easily.

## Hair, Make-up & Nails

- Students' hair should look natural and well-groomed, not extreme or distracting. Color should look natural.
- No makeup is allowed on regular or dress-down days.
- One or two pairs of post earrings may be worn by girls. Dangling or hoop earrings are not allowed. Boys may not wear earrings.

# SSP Dress-Down Days

The letter of the law is not as important as observing modesty, respect, and dignity.

#### General Rules:

- Uniform guidelines regarding short and skirt length, shoe safety, jewelry, and makeup apply.
- Clothes and accessories may not promote alcohol, tobacco, drugs, violence, or disrespect of others, nor may they carry messages of an inappropriate nature.
- Clothes and accessories may not promote politics or political parties.
- Clothing must be neat and clean, not frayed, torn, cut, ragged, or holey.
- Clothes are to be worn as designed.
- If a theme or specific guidelines are given, the student must wear clothes that follow the theme or guidelines OR must wear the regular school uniform.

## **Enforced Policy**

Faculty may address the appropriateness of any attire or accessory.

Failure to follow guidelines will prohibit participation in the next dress-down day. A second offense will result in the loss of dress-down days for the remainder of the year.

Final decisions regarding the wearing or appropriateness of clothing or accessories are left to the discretion of the principal.

# Unsure if you got it right?

If you do not want to risk a call home for inappropriate clothing, have your child bring their uniform in their backpack just in case.

#### Shoes

- Athletic shoes must be worn for PE class.
- Other safe shoes (Uggs, boots, Vans, Toms, etc.) are fine for dress-down days.

### Tops

- Students may not wear short t-shirts, spaghetti straps, strapless shirts, or any clothing that bares shoulders, stomachs, backs, or midriffs.
- Shirts may be worn underneath or a sweater over the top of these types of clothing.
- Sleeveless shirts with wide straps of 3-fingers width are fine, but basketball jerseys must be worn with t-shirt underneath.
- Shirts, blouses, sweatshirts, sweaters, and jackets must be neat and clean.

#### **Bottoms**

- Leggings may only be worn under a skirt, dress, or pants, not AS pants. Yoga or tightfitting pants / shorts should only be worn with a long shirt, tunic, or sweater.
- Students may not wear low-cut pants

#### Hats

 Hats / head coverings may be worn inside only with the teacher's permission.
